

Silas Emerian Shines at North American Speedcubing Championship

19-Year-Old Finalist in Square-1 Event, Ranks Among Top 100 Globally During Rubik's 50th Anniversary

Silas Emerian, 19, recently competed at the Rubik's North American Championship for speedcubing in Minneapolis, MN. He competed in ten events, including the 2x2, 3x3, 4x4 and 5x5 cubes, among others.

Silas was a finalist in the Square-1 event, finishing 14th out of 311 competitors, and is currently ranked #71 in the world for the Square-1 (average). He finished 62nd out of 831 competitors in the popular 3x3 event. Silas has been competing for the past 5 years.

This is the 50th anniversary of the iconic puzzle, invented in 1974 by Hungarian sculptor and professor of architecture Erno Rubik.

Zaven Khanjian, Longtime AMAA Executive Director and Community Leader, Passes Away at 80

Legacy of Faith and Service Remembered by Family, Friends, and the Armenian Evangelical Community - by Phil Tavlian


Zaven Khanjian -- Executive Director/CEO of the Armenian Missionary Association of America and frequent visitor to FAPC -- passed away in Glendale, California on August 9, 2024 at the age of 80.

A native of Aleppo, Syria, Zaven received his early education at Aleppo College and earned a Bachelor's Degree in Business Administration from the American University of Beirut in 1967.

After graduation, he moved to the Persian Gulf and engaged in business pursuits for more than a dozen years. The Khanjian Family relocated to Southern California in 1979 and Zaven eventually started his own property brokerage company, Kanjyan Realty, in Glendale in 1987.

On September 1, 2024, he was appointed Executive Director of the AMAA. During his decade tenure, Zaven oversaw the opening of the Khoren and Shooshanig Avedisian School in Yerevan, the commemoration of the

Centennial of the Armenian Genocide in 2015, and the Centenary of the AMAA in 2018.



A prolific writer, Zaven authored three Armenian language books: "Ays dune Kuget e Te Ims?" (Is This Your House or Mine?), "Srdi yev Mdki Tsolker" (Reflections of the Mind and Soul), and "Haleb Arachine Gayaran" (Memoirs of a Memorable Childhood). On September 13, 2019, the Writers' Union of Armenian conferred the title of Honorary Member upon Zaven for his books and articles on Armenia.

Zaven was preceded in death by his parents, Vasken and Verjian Khanjan (both Genocide survivors), and his sister Anahid Terjimanian, who passed in April 2024. He is survived by his beloved wife of more than 50 years, the former Sona Kelligian; his children, Vasken, Hrag and his wife Michelle, and Vana and her husband Armen Vartanian; six grandchildren; and siblings Laura Prather, Dicky Dodd, and Dikran and Mariette Asdghig Khanjian.






